Snapchat

Snapchat has an update, which if not turned off can now show the location where people are. As this could pose to be a safety and security issue please find below instructions to turn this off (**Please note: accounts only accessible if you are 13 years old.**)

After updating to the newest version of Snapchat (version 10.11.0.0) that includes the Snap Map feature, just pinch generously on the camera screen to access the Snap Map. Since this is your first time accessing it, you'll be prompted to choose your preferences. If you haven't already given Snapchat access to your location data, you'll be prompted to do so before continuing.

Just hit "Next" until you see the choice for who can see your location on the Snap Map. Select "Only Me (Ghost Mode)" and hit "Next," then "Finish" to finalise it.
